



In our Gospel reading today, Christ preaches to the crowds gathered with Him at the mountain. These words and teachings are known as the Beatitudes, and they give us a roadmap and insight as to how we ought to live and serve others. We are reminded again at the end of this teaching that, “your reward will be great in heaven.” Our goal and our greatest desire is to love and know God in this world and then to serve Him for all eternity in the next. We might often wonder how best we are called to “serve God” in our daily lives in this world. In these often trying and confrontational times, strive to be the voice of love and respect to all you encounter. Offer a helping hand to those in your lives who are in need, pray for those who might be experiencing sickness or depression, and continue to look for ways to give back to your Parish and your community. As we have talked about with our middle school Edge students this past week, by the virtue of our Baptism we are not only welcomed into the family of God, we are commanded and challenged to live a life both pleasing and acceptable in God's eyes. Baptism washes away the stain of original sin and, through the grace of God, gives us the ability to enter the heavenly kingdom at the end of our earthly lives. This week let us pray most especially for all missionaries who serve the Church of God around the world and in our local communities, that the teachings of Christ in the Beatitudes might guide them in all that they do.
